Feeling Disconnected?



Military life, especially deployments or mobilizations, can present challenges to service members and their families that are both unique and difficult. Many times we can successfully deal with them on our own. However, how can we know if it will get worse?

Take 5 minutes and complete a totally anonymous and voluntary self-assessment to see where you are at (there are six types of assessments to choose from).

It will tell you whether or not you have symptoms that are consistent with a condition or concern that would benefit from further evaluation or treatment. It will also give you guidance as to where you might seek assistance.

Employment and USA Jobs



Interested in federal employment (without prior experience)? USA Jobs is the site where you would search and apply. A couple things to be aware of is that USA Jobs collects pools of applications (there may not be an actual opening) and spouses who apply may have spouse preference. Here are a few tips to assist you:

1. In addition to checking out the USA Jobs Guide at <http://afrc.avianoab.info/programs-careerfocus.html> recommend that you MATCH each OPENING with the INTERNAL job openings https://ww2.afpc.randolph.af.mil/resweb/job_search_advanced_nlo.asp If there is a MATCH then you will know that there is an OPENING.
2. At the USA Jobs website on the bottom of the page, when you are asked about Applicant Eligibility "A Person with Non-Competitive Appointment Eligibility", answer YES. (Spouse Preference).
3. After you have applied for the position your status should change from "Application Started" to "Resume Received". You may also want to check the status at the below link <https://ww2.afpc.randolph.af.mil/resweb/contactus.asp>

Student Online Achievement Resource (SOAR)

Are you concerned about your child's academic transition into the new school? SOAR is a program for military families which aims to address the unique challenges facing military children who frequently relocate.
