## Who Can Use the Airman & Family Readiness Center?

The A&FRC is chartered as a primary prevention agency and functions to ensure resources required to support active duty and their families are available. The A&FRC designs, develops, and conducts family programs according to base and community requirements and capabilities. Services are available for active duty and their families, DoD civilians, retirees, and includes our single airmen.

## What Types of Resources Are Available?

The Aviano A&FRC offers a variety of services including information and referral, financial, relocation assistance, transition assistance, employment programs, spouse orientations, and more! Other classes will be created in keeping with the needs and requests of the Aviano Community.

## Leadership Consultation

Community Readiness Consultants provide leadership consultation to promote the successful adaptation of Airmen and their families to the demands of military life and facilitate the personal readiness of the Total Force.

## A&FRC Programs

### *Air Force Aid Society*

Provides emergency financial assistance to Air Force members, both active duty and retired and their families through interest-free loans or grants.

Emergency assistance can include:

- Rent
- Food
- Utility bills
- Emergency travel due to death/critical illness in the family
- Car repairs
- Medical/dental expenses
- Education loans/grants

### *Employment Assistance*

Helps enhance the marketability and employability of spouses and active duty members through individual career counseling and classes to include:

- Resume
- Interview
- Federal Employment

### *Family Life Education*

Enhances the well-being of families and strengthens their adaptation to the unique demands of the Air Force life.

### *Information and Referral*

Assists individuals and families identify and clarify needs, determine appropriate forms of assistance and provide linkage to resources, including exceptional family member resources.
