EMPLOYMENT CLASS, 15 June, 0800-1200. This workshop enhances the marketability and employability of spouses and active duty members and thoroughly discusses developing a resume, effective interviewing techniques, and job search skills.

SPONSORSHIP TRAINING, 1 & 15 June, 1400-1500. All first time active duty sponsors and those who have not had training in over a year are required to attend sponsorship training. The training reviews the basic requirements of sponsorship and provides useful resources to better assist the newcomer.

PRE-DEPLOYMENT READINESS BRIEFING, 3, 10, 17, & 24 June, 1300-1430. This class is required for all those going TDY or deploying for more than 30 days and will fulfill your pre-deployment checklist requirement.

RE-INTEGRATION BRIEFING, 1, 3, 5, 8, 10, 15, 17, 19, 22, 24, 26 & 29 June, 0900-1000. The reintegration process is designed to assist Airmen and family members who have endured hardships and sacrifices associated with deployment. It is a collective effort from base agencies to effectively reintegrate the members into the home front, work center, and the community.

PRE-SEPARATION BRIEFING, 9 & 23 June, 1300-1500. This class fulfills the mandatory requirement for all personnel retiring/separating from the military. **This class should be completed 90 days before separation/retirement.**

SPOUSE IT UP, 17 June, 1030-1300. Spouses networking, having good food, and appreciating one another. Children invited as day care will be available.

COUPLES CONNECTION VIA CANDLE LIGHT DINNER, 19 June, 1830-2100. The seminar enhances the well-being of couples and strengthens their adaptation to the unique demands of the Air Force Life.

TRANSITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM 3-DAY WORKSHOP, 9 –10, 0800-1700. TAP workshops are conducted by trained DOL facilitators. Participants will learn to write effective resumes and cover letters, interviewing techniques and successful job search methods.

BASIC INVESTING, 16 June, 1400-1600. Delve into the world of TSP, certificate of deposits, stocks, bonds, mutual funds and IRAs. Great, detailed info to get you started putting your money to work for you!

MONEY TALK CLASS, 2 June, 1400-1530. This money management class includes goal setting, financial planning, credit reports and debt management. Individuals leave the class with important tools necessary to become financially sound.

SMOOTH MOVE, 5, 19, & 26 June, 0830-1030: Provides a consolidated 2-hr briefing of relocation services brought to you by Wing agencies such as AMC, TMO Household goods, Finance, Housing, Legal, etc. and equips you with all the information you will need for a Smooth Move PCS from Aviano AB, Italy.

RIGHT START: 11 May 09

1. Right Start Begins on either Monday (0800) or Thursday (0800):

Monday Start Date: If the newcomer arrives on Thursday, Friday, Saturday or Sunday then they will begin on Monday.

Thursday Start Date: If the newcomer arrives on Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday then they will begin on Thursday.

2. Registration for Right Start: Call to register the newcomers for Right Start (Monday or Thursday) at 632-5407. Based on the number of newcomers, Right Start may be held Mass Briefing Facility.

3. Right Start starts at 0800 and covers four days; Wednesday is dedicated for house hunting for families or squadron in-processing for dorm residents.

4. AFI Testing is on-line only. Members are still required to attend the safety briefing.
