Reporting requirement

AFI 40-301, Chap 1.16 requires that:

- All active duty members and civilian employees report all incidents of suspected family maltreatment to the Family Advocacy Program.
- Includes:
 - Physical maltreatment
 - Emotional maltreatment
 - Sexual maltreatment
 - Neglect
